6. Pill - (1) a teacher (2) an unlikable person

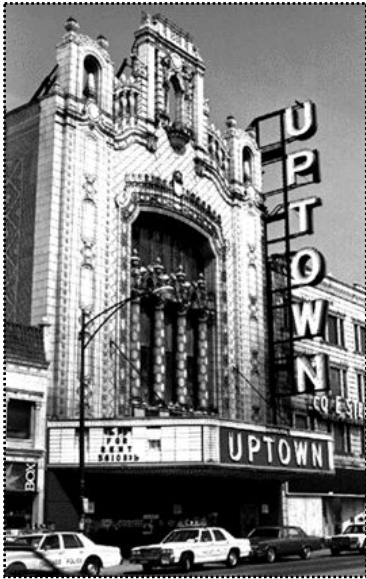
